



**Figure S26** Genome-wide scan for quantitative trait loci (QTL) associated with canopy height across two years under two irrigation regimes, water-limited (WL, top panel) and well-watered (WW, bottom panel). Color is representative of the estimated additive allelic effect, with red and blue colors indicating increased and decreased canopy height, respectively, when substituting a NM24016 allele with an allele from TM-1. The intensity of the color represents the magnitude of the logarithm of odds (LOD) score with 3.3 as the significance threshold to declare QTL – values above 3.3 were assigned a value of 4 for presentation purposes. The left-hand y-axis denotes day of the growing season (Julian calendar) that data were collected, and the right-hand y-axis denotes year. The x-axis represents the mapped chromosomes of tetraploid cotton with marker intervals in centimorgans (cM). Chromosomes A04 and D13 did not have any mapped markers.
