



Figure S9 Population-Specific Site Frequency Spectra for Four Classes of SNPs

Unfolded SNP site frequency spectra (SFS) for four classes of SNPs separated by autosomes (A) and Chromosome X (B) for each population. Note that the X-axis varies between populations due to varying sample sizes. Most differences in SFS reside between the low frequency bins between the African sample and all non-African samples. There are also a notable X-effect observed in the reduction of low frequency variants for the non-African samples. NonSyn = nonsynonymous sites; Syn = synonymous sites.
