



Figure S3 Protein domain structures from NCBI conserved domain search. (A) DNAAF1, 634 amino acids. Double-headed arrow (filled black) indicates a region corresponding to Exon 4. (B) LRR48, 523 amino acids. Double-headed arrow (filled black) indicates a region corresponding to Exon 4, including the 89th amino acid leucine (red bulb). Locations of the leucine-rich repeat domains are indicated as Double-headed arrow. Both mutations are within the leucine-rich repeat domain.
